

OFFICIAL RULES

American Medical Political Action Committee (“Sponsor”)

AMPAC’s Southern Charms Sweepstakes (“Sweepstakes”)

1. The American Medical Political Action Committee (“AMPAC”)-sponsored Sweepstakes is open to (a) 2026 AMPAC donors who have made Qualifying Donations and (b) members of the Restricted Class (defined below) who submit an index card as described below. Qualifying Donations are those contributions to the AMPAC Fund for the 2026 membership year delivered to a designated AMPAC agent in the Washington, DC Headquarters by 5:00 p.m. Eastern Time, Friday, October 23, 2026 (“Deadline”). Sweepstakes entries shall be allocated as follows:
 - Non-resident/non-medical student members of the Restricted Class who made Qualifying Donations for the 2026 membership year shall receive one (1) Sweepstakes entry for each \$500 contribution increment.
 - Resident/medical student members of the Restricted Class who made Qualifying Donations for the 2026 membership year shall receive one (1) Sweepstakes entry for each \$250 contribution increment.
 - Capitol Club Diamond Donors are (a) those non-resident/non-medical student members of the Restricted Class who made a minimum Qualifying Donation of five thousand dollars (\$5,000) for the 2026 membership year; and (b) those resident/medical student members of the Restricted Class who made a minimum Qualifying Donations of two thousand five hundred dollars (\$2,500) for the 2026 membership year. Capitol Club Diamond Qualifying Donors shall receive a minimum of five (5) entries into the Sweepstakes.
 - Capitol Club Platinum Donors are (a) those non-resident/non-medical student members of the Restricted Class who made a minimum Qualifying Donation of two thousand five hundred dollars (\$2,500) for the 2026 membership year; and (b) those resident/medical student members of the Restricted Class who made a minimum Qualifying Donations of one thousand two hundred fifty dollars (\$1,250) for the 2026 membership year. Capitol Club Platinum Qualifying Donors shall receive a minimum of three (3) entries into the Sweepstakes.
 - Capitol Club Gold Donors are (a) those non-resident/non-medical student members of the Restricted Class who made a minimum Qualifying Donation of a thousand dollars (\$1,000) for the 2026 membership year; and (b) those resident/medical student members of the Restricted Class who made a minimum Qualifying Donations of five hundred dollars (\$500) for the 2026 membership year. Capitol Club Gold Qualifying Donors shall each receive a minimum of two (2) entries into the Sweepstakes.
 - Capitol Club Silver Donors are (a) those non-resident/non-medical student members of the Restricted Class who made a minimum Qualifying Donation of five hundred dollars (\$500) for the 2026 membership year; and (b) those resident/medical student members of the Restricted Class who made a minimum Qualifying Donation of two hundred fifty dollars (\$250) for the 2026 membership year. Capitol Club Silver Qualifying Donors shall each receive a minimum of one (1) entry into the Sweepstakes.
 - **NO PURCHASE NECESSARY.** As an alternate method of entry, on a plain 3”x 5” card, legibly handprint with the words *“Promoting the Art and Science of Medicine*

and the Betterment of Public Health" and your name, phone number, and email address. Then, mail the 3"x 5" card in a first-class, stamped envelope to the American Medical Political Action Committee, Republic Square 1, 25 Massachusetts Avenue, NW, #600, Washington, D.C. 20001, Attention: Nicole Lonetto, Sweepstakes Director. Alternate-method entrants shall receive one (1) entry into the Sweepstakes. No copies, facsimile, computer generated, or mechanically reproduced, illegible, or incomplete entries will be accepted. Sponsor is not responsible for lost, late, illegible, misdirected, mutilated, incomplete, or postage-due mail/entries. Each entrant is responsible to keep Sponsor advised of any change of email, mailing address, and/or telephone number of entrant. All card entries must be received before the Deadline to be eligible for the Sweepstakes. All entries will become the property of the Sponsor and will not be returned. Index card entries may be submitted without making a contribution to AMPAC if entries are submitted to AMPAC before 5:00 p.m. Eastern Time on Friday, October 23, 2026.

Members of the Restricted Class include individuals who are 18 years or older and are:

- (a) Members of the American Medical Association; or
- (b) Members of a state medical association; or
- (c) Members of a county medical association; or
- (d) Family members of individuals in categories (a), (b) or (c) above;
- (e) American citizens or immigrants with a Green Card; and
- (f) Not federal contractors.

Current Officers of the AMA Board of Trustees and Employees of the American Medical Association or state or county associations (and their immediate family members) are not eligible to participate.

2. Contributions are not deductible for income tax purposes. Contributions to AMPAC are voluntary and are used for political purposes. You may refuse to contribute without reprisal and AMPAC, the American Medical Association, or any affiliated state medical associations will not favor or disfavor any member because of the amount contributed. Individuals who have previously contributed to AMPAC may make additional donations so long as that individual's total contribution for 2026 membership year does not exceed Five Thousand Dollars (\$5,000).
3. The winner will be determined in a random drawing from all eligible entries on Wednesday, October 28, 2026, at the AMA's Washington, DC Headquarters ("winner"). The announcement will take place during the AMA's Interim meeting at the Walt Disney World Swan and Dolphin Resort, 1200 Epcot Resorts Blvd, Lake Buena Vista, FL 32830. The AMPAC Chair will announce the winner during AMPAC's Capitol Club luncheon. Sweepstakes entrants need not be present to win.
4. If the winner is not present during the announcement, the winner will be notified by a certified mailing (return receipt requested) sent to winner's last known address within five (5) business days of the Sweepstakes drawing. No prize substitutions will be available. If

the prize is not accepted within ten (10) calendar days after receipt of notification, the prize will be forfeited and awarded to an alternate winner.

5. Odds of winning will be determined by the total number of Sweepstakes entries submitted before the drawing by the Deadline.
6. The winner will be required to sign and return the AMPAC-provided Affidavit of Eligibility and Liability/Publicity Release form, within the ten (10) calendar day window before collecting their prize or the prize will be forfeited. Guest accompanying winner (“travel companion”) must sign and return an Affidavit of Eligibility and Liability/Publicity Release prior to travel.
7. The prize awarded to the eligible winner is not transferable. Winner of the Sweepstakes will be required to sign and return to the Sponsor an Affidavit of Eligibility and Liability/Publicity Release Form, including applicable tax forms, before receiving the prize. Refusal or failure to sign and return the Affidavit of Eligibility and Liability/Publicity Release Form and applicable tax forms within fourteen (14) days from first attempted notification will result in forfeiture of the prize and the prize will be awarded to an alternate winner. Prize(s) will be awarded within thirty (30) days after receipt of Affidavit/Release. If Affidavit/Release is returned as undeliverable, it will result in disqualification, and the corresponding prize will be awarded to an alternate winner. If a prize is forfeited for any reason whatsoever, the forfeited prize will be awarded to an alternate winner. Except where prohibited by law, acceptance of the prize constitutes winner’s consent to use his/her name, likeness, and biographical data for the Sponsor’s promotional purposes without additional compensation. All federal, state, and local laws apply. **Void where prohibited.** The decisions of the Sponsor on all matters relating to this Sweepstakes are final in all respects.

At the time of the drawing, extra alternate winners will be selected. An alternate winner may receive the Grand Prize if the originally selected winner declines the prize, is disqualified, or otherwise determined to be ineligible. If any correspondence of the Sweepstakes or any prize is returned as undeliverable, the corresponding prize will be forfeited and will be awarded to an alternate winner. Should winner make any false statement(s) in any document referenced above, winner will be required to promptly return to Sponsor his/her/their prize. Any unclaimed prizes will be awarded in a random drawing to be held as necessary. In the event there is a dispute of the entrant’s identity, the prize will be awarded to the established email account associated with the entry.

As a condition of entering, entrant(s) agree: (a) to release Sponsor, its affiliates, retailers, sales representatives, distributors, and each of their officers, directors, employees, representatives, and agents from any and all liability, loss or damage incurred with respect to the awarding, receipt, possession, and/or use or misuse of any prize, (b) under no circumstances will entrant be permitted to obtain awards for, and participant hereby waives all rights to claim, punitive, incidental, consequential, or any other damages; (c) all causes of action arising out of or connected with this Sweepstakes, or any prize awarded, shall be resolved individually, without resort to any form of class action; and (d) any and

all claims, judgments, and award shall be limited to actual out-of-pocket costs incurred, excluding attorneys' fees and court costs.
